## Daylight Saving Time

On November 5, 2023, daylight saving time (DST) will be over for this year. That weekend we will move our clocks back one hour to reclaim the hour we lost in March. Though two states, Hawaii and Arizona, do not observe DST, and a number of states have passed laws to stay on it all year, until there is a national consensus regarding this issue, things will remain the way they are now. I don't know how you feel about "spring forward" and "fall back," but I'd prefer that we pick one and stay on it all the time. I'm not a fan of moving the clocks twice every year.

That said, I'd like for us to focus on the word "saving."
