## Eat, Drink, and Be Merry?

Have you ever considered how you would live your life if you unexpectedly came into an enormous sum of money? I am talking about enough money to do whatever you wanted and never need to work ever again. Would you continue to work at your job, or would you walk out of the door never to be seen there again? Would you have the attitude expressed in the title – eat, drink, and be merry?

The Bible teaches us that riches can change our lives, and not for the better. Consider the following:

- For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows (1 Tim. 6:10).
- It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God (Mark 10:25).
- Lay not up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do break through and steal: but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through or steal (Matt. 6:19-20).

These verses teach that being really interested in money can be very detrimental to one's spiritual health. Note Jesus' teaching in the parable of the rich fool. A rich man reaped a plentiful harvest, so bountiful that he reasoned he needed bigger barns to store it all. Then he thought he could take it easy in life – eat, drink, and be merry. What he did not know was that his soul was in jeopardy that very night! And so it shall be for all who are rich toward themselves, and not rich toward God (Luke 12:16ff).

We should consider these warnings from God about being too interested in material possessions and riches because our interest should be in getting to heaven. While the scriptures do not teach that we will eat, drink, and be merry in heaven, we will have access to the river of water of life and to the tree of life. We will also have all tears wiped away with no more sorrow, pain, sickness, or death. That is what makes getting to heaven so alluring. Eternity with the Father and the Son – and nothing on earth can compare with that.
