### All Have Sinned

Several Bible passages are helpful in understanding our sinfulness. As we discuss some of them, let each of us do a self-examination to see how they might apply to us.

In **John 8:1ff**, Jesus was teaching in the temple when He was approached by some scribes and Pharisees, and they had with them a woman who had been caught in the act of adultery. They set her in the midst of the group, then asked Jesus if she should be stoned as Moses taught in the law. Jesus, knowing their hearts, did not respond at first, but they persisted until He answered: "He that is without sin among you, let him cast the first stone." Convicted by their conscience, they walked away one by one.

In **1** Cor 6:9ff, Paul reminded the brethren that the unrighteous would not enter the kingdom of God. After citing ten specific sins, he told the Corinthian brethren, "And such were some of you..."

In **Rom 3:23**, Paul affirmed the conclusion that *all have* sinned and come short of the glory of God. Contextually he was speaking about Jews and Gentiles, but it applies to each of us also. Every accountable person has sinned.

Addressing Christians in **1 John 1:7ff**, John encourages us to walk in the light. He goes on to warn that if we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, the truth is not in us, and we are liars.

One cannot read these verses and conclude that he or she is without sin. Fortunately we have a loving, gracious, merciful, and longsuffering Father who is sincerely interested that we come to repentance. May we recognize that these passages apply to us, too, and then do our best to walk in the light so that the blood of Christ will continue to cleanse us.
