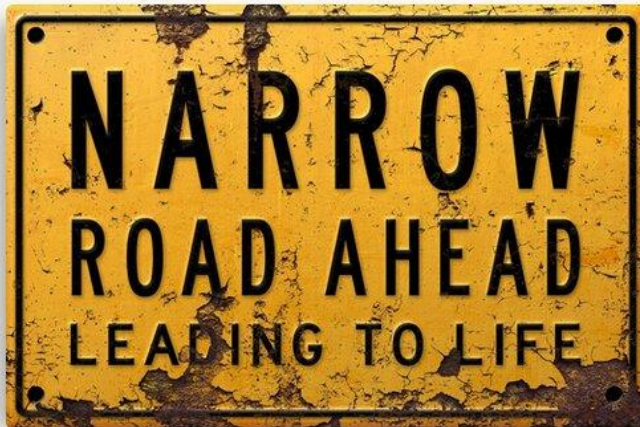
In **Numbers 13-14**, Moses selected a representative sample of the twelve tribes to spy out the Promised Land. The group was comprised of one member from each tribe. When these men returned, the majority – ten of the twelve – reported that even though the land was just as God had described, they would be unable to defeat the inhabitants. Two spies, Joshua and Caleb, implored the camp to believe that God would deliver on His promise, but the majority of the Israelites agreed with the majority of the spies. This unbelief resulted in God punishing Israel with forty years of wandering in the wilderness. The majority was not right in this instance.

In **1 Kings 18**, Elijah the prophet challenged King Ahab and the four hundred fifty prophets of Baal. Though the prophets of Baal believed in their god, only the God of heaven responded during this challenge. The majority was not right.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus talked about the many (majority) and the few: *Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it (Matt. 7:13-14).* Many versus few? The majority is headed to hell.

The majority may rule in most instances, but it is certain that they are not always right. In spiritual matters, the majority will be wrong, as they will discover much to their dismay on Judgment Day. Take your stand with the few.
