According to Britannica.com, "...it was modified to yield 50 megatons...about 3,800 times the strength of the U.S. bomb dropped on Hiroshima during World War II. It exploded about 2.5 miles (4 km) above the ground, producing a mushroom cloud more than 37 miles (60 km) high." The Hiroshima bomb alone was devastating, killing 135,000 Japanese people. Destruction has always been easier than creating something new. What is more impressive: the child who kicks over the sandcastle, or the child who built it? Not only did God

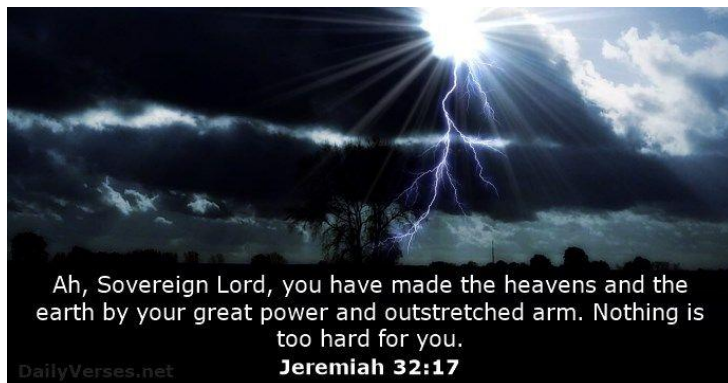
create our world, He created everything in it, everything sustaining it, and everything surrounding it. God, the Almighty created it all.
