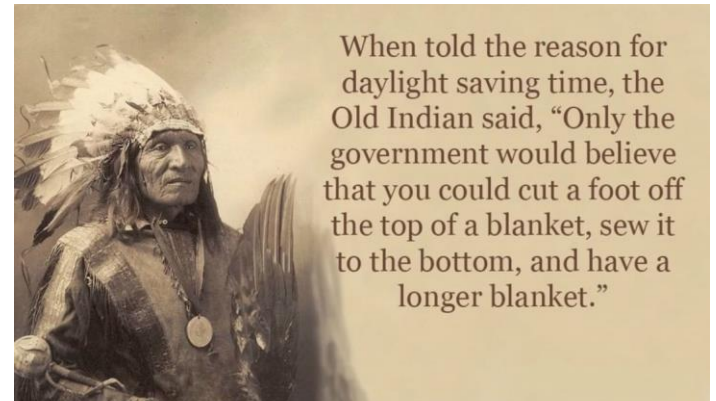
### Remember in Prayer ...
