Moral Corruption

Often during our public worship, we pray for the leaders of our country that we may be able to continue to worship without fear. This is something that we ought to do. In fact, we need to pray not just for our leaders, but for all mankind (1 Tim. **2:1-2**). We currently live in an environment which is accurately described by several passages in the Bible. Our society is becoming full of those who "heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears" (2 Tim 4:3) because of the intense desire to "call good evil, and evil good" (Isa. 5:20). It is easy to see the similarity between Paul's description of God having given up the Gentiles to perverseness and wickedness (Rom. 1:18ff), and the cultural and religious slide we are on in our beloved country. We are no longer "one nation under God," because we can no longer truthfully say "in God we trust." Just as has been the case with every world power, the USA is on the precipice of falling away from what made us great. I believe the fall is due to two main reasons.

First, we are corrupt from the top down. Our elected leaders are more concerned with greed, power, and re-election than in governing our country and making godly decisions. Our government is comprised of those who do not even blink when telling a lie, and will court even the most perverse groups of potential voters in order to win the next election. Over the past several decades we have seen God and morals removed from our state and federal courts and legislatures, as well as our public schools. We are being forced to accept adultery, gambling, drugs & alcohol, and even homosexuality as normal under the guise of tolerance and political correctness. This has emanated from the leadership.

Second, we are corrupt from the bottom up. Things which used to make our parents and grandparents blush to even whisper are now commonplace at school and in public.
