One Question


We communicate with each other in a variety of ways, one of which is by asking questions. Some ask questions out of curiosity. For example, our kids may ask, "Why is the sky blue?" or "Where do babies come from?" Others may ask questions in defiance of authority: "Why do I have to clean the kitchen?" or "Why can't I go out with my friends?" Then there are those who have a sincere desire for knowledge: "What is dry ice?" or, "How do I find the square root of a number?"

Many questions are recorded in the Scriptures: Satan asked Eve, "Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?" (Gen. 3:1).... God asked Cain, "If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted?" (Gen. 4:7).... Pharaoh asked Moses, "Who is the Lord, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go?" (Ex. 5:2).... Jesus was asked, "By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority?" (Matt. 21:23).... And a little later He was asked, "Master, which is the greatest commandment in the law?" (Matt. 22:36).... Paul queried the church in Rome, "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?" (Rom. 8:35).... The Hebrew writer inquired, "How shall we escape if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and *was confirmed unto us by them which heard him?"* (**Heb. 2:3**).... Satan desired to deceive, Pharaoh challenged God's authority, and Paul at times asked rhetorical questions to spur his audience to think. The questions we find in Scripture are there to help instruct and encourage us in our faith.

Suppose you were given the opportunity to ask any Bible character one question. What would you ask and of whom would you ask it? Perhaps you might ask Adam and Eve why they ate that fruit, or the Israelites how manna tasted, or Pharaoh why it took so long for him to let the Israelites go. Someone would surely ask Paul about that thorn in the flesh! I can also imagine some asking the apostles if it's okay to use instruments of music in worship, or if baptism is really necessary for salvation.

The single-most important question anyone can ask in this life, however, is, "Am I saved and am I walking that narrow path headed to heaven for eternity?" The Bible contains the answer to that question. Are you sincerely interested in the answer?
