## God Has Spoken

God has used various ways to communicate with man. He spoke directly to the Gentile fathers from the beginning until the time of Christ in what is known as the Patriarchal Age. He gave prophets and a written law to the Jews from the time of Moses until the time of Christ – the Mosaic Age. In the remainder of the first century and just beyond, the apostles provided the instruction in God's word. Ultimately their inspired writings were assembled with the Old Testament writings to form the Bible, the inspired word of God.

In a letter to Timothy, Paul wrote that the Scriptures were given by the inspiration of God and are able to instruct us in how to become a Christian, as well as how to live and worship as a Christian (2 Tim 3:15ff). In the longest chapter in the Bible, Psalm 119, we find several familiar passages which stress the importance of the word of God: hiding the word in our heart aids us in avoiding sin; God's law is better for us than silver or gold; and the word of God is a light for our feet and a lamp for our paths.

Since the word of God is so important to us, it makes perfect sense that we would spend time reading and studying. Giving diligence to this task will help us be better able to rightly divide, or handle aright, the word of God (2 Tim 2:15). Did you know that by reading nine chapters per day you can read the entire New Testament in a month? Imagine how familiar we could become with the New Testament if we did this each month! By devoting just a little time each day, we can read through the New Testament several times this year. Only by filling our hearts with His word can we hope to become the children our Father would have us to be.
