As we gather this week, let us reflect on what it means to live sacrificially for Christ. In Romans 12:1, Paul urges us, "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship." This call is more than just a command; it is an invitation to live in a way that honors God with everything we are—our time, our resources, our relationships, and our very lives.

To live as a living sacrifice means to offer up ourselves daily to God, choosing to serve Him in all things. It means living with an eternal perspective, not focused on the fleeting pleasures of this world, but on the lasting joy and fulfillment that comes from serving our Savior. It's about choosing to follow His example of love, humility, and sacrifice, even when it's difficult or uncomfortable.

As we continue our journey of faith, let us remember that our lives are not our own. We are called to live for God's purposes, to be a reflection of His love, and to serve others in His name. May we honor Him with our lives, giving of ourselves fully to the one who gave everything for us.

Let us strive to live this week in light of the great sacrifice of Jesus, offering ourselves as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God, as our act of worship. May our lives be a testimony to His love and grace.
