When we think about the “narrow road,” it’s easy to imagine some dramatic, life-altering moment where we choose God over the world. But in reality, the narrow way is built by hundreds of small steps, tiny, daily decisions to put God first.

The wide road, by contrast, doesn’t require a decision at all. It’s automatic. It’s passive. You can be on it without even realizing it, just by going with the flow—by letting your priorities slip, by letting your Bible collect dust, by letting Sunday morning worship become optional, by choosing comfort over commitment.

But the narrow road? It’s not paved with ease. It’s paved with intention.

It’s the teenager who chooses to turn off a show that doesn’t honor God.

It’s the dad who puts down his phone to read the Bible with his kids.

It’s the mom who forgives someone even when no apology comes.

It’s the Christian who still shows up to worship, even when their week was hard and their heart is heavy.

These aren’t glamorous choices. They’re not always noticed. But they’re the steps of the narrow road.

Jesus never promised the narrow way would be popular. He said few would find it. But what He did promise is life, real, abundant, eternal life.

And here’s the comfort: You don’t have to walk that path alone. Jesus walks it with you. Every step you take in obedience, every prayer you whisper when no one else hears, every time you say “no” to sin and “yes” to God, you are not alone.

So today, as you read this bulletin or sit quietly in your pew, ask yourself: What small step can I take today to walk more closely with Jesus? Maybe it’s a conversation. Maybe it’s repentance. Maybe it’s reaching out to someone who’s struggling. Or maybe it’s finally saying, “I’m ready to walk through that narrow gate.”

Big changes begin with small choices.

And small choices, made faithfully, can lead to a road that never ends.

Let’s walk it together.
