This morning, as we gather at the Lord's table, we join with Christians all over the world in remembering the greatest sacrifice ever made. Every Sunday, just as the early church did, we pause to take the bread and the cup in memory of Jesus (Acts 20:7).

Paul wrote, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes" (1 Corinthians 11:26). When we partake, we are preaching a sermon without words. We are declaring together that Jesus died, that He rose again, and that one day He will return.

The bread reminds us of His body, broken for us (Luke 22:19). The cup reminds us of His blood, shed for the forgiveness of sins (Matthew 26:28). As we take these emblems, we remember not only the cross, but the love of our Father who gave His Son for us (John 3:16).

The Lord's Supper is not just a habit; it is a holy moment. Paul urges us to "examine ourselves" (1 Corinthians 11:28). That means humbling our hearts, reflecting on God's grace, and offering Him sincere thanksgiving. In these few quiet moments of silent prayer, let us give thanks for His mercy, His forgiveness, and His never-ending love.

This table pulls us back to what matters most. It reminds us that salvation is not about our works, but about His sacrifice. It reminds us that we are not alone, but part of one body gathered around one table (1 Corinthians 10:17). And it reminds us that we have a hope that reaches beyond this world, the promise of being with Christ forever.

May we approach this time with reverence, with gratitude, and with humble hearts—thanking God for the Lamb who was slain, and living in hope of the day when He will come again.
